

New role for a freelance grants and trust fundraiser at RESPOND

Respond is looking to appoint a freelance grants and trust fundraiser to secure new funding for our advocacy and psychotherapy services.

Based in London, we have contracts with ICB's and NHS Foundation Trusts across the Country and work solely with autistic people and people with learning disabilities to reduce the impact of trauma, over 40% of the children and adults that use our therapy services have experienced sexual abuse or assault.

Our new freelance fundraiser will have a demonstrable track record of successful income generation through grants and trust applications within the charitable sector and have the ability to bring our great work alive through compelling applications.

Ideally, we hope to start our new fundraiser as soon as possible and the work will be time limited so that we can front load a number of key applications at the start of the financial year. We are flexible and envisage this will be equivalent of around 24 days work, which could be worked over a 3-5 month period.

Working with our Head of Development and Commissioning on an identified pipeline of opportunities, based at home with potential travel to London if required on occasion.
